#### ► THIS WEEK IN AIR FORCE HISTORY

Oct. 27, 2006 - The 49th Fight Wing flew 25 F-117 Nighthawks in formation over Holloman AFB, New Mexico, as part of the aircraft's 25th anniversary and 250,000-flying-hour celebration. The formation consisted of 25 planes staggered into five separate groups.

**Oct. 28, 1985** - The first six female officers started initial qualification training for Minuteman crew duty. All six women previously worked with the Titan II system. They finished the class on February 7, 1986.

Oct 29, 1950 - C-47s made aeromedical flights from Sinanju Airfield, North Korea, the northernmost Korean airfield ever used by Far East Air Forces aircraft, some 40 miles north of Pyongyang.

Oct 30, 1940 - The 71st Squadron Royal Air Force (1st Eagle Squadron with American volunteers) became operational.

**Oct. 31, 1972** - The Air Force inactivated the last BOMARC surface-to-air missile squadron, the 22d Air Defense Missile Squadron, at Langley Air Force Base, Virginia.

**Nov. 1, 1954** - The Air Force retired its last <u>B-29 Superfortress</u> from service. Flown primarily by the United States during World War II and the Korean War, the aircraft had fewer than 12 years in active inventory.

**Nov. 2, 1944** - While on a mission over Merseberg, Germany, a bomber sustained three hits from anti-aircraft shells. Severely wounded navigator <a href="Lt. Robert E. Femoyer">Lt. Robert E. Femoyer</a> refused morphine so that he could keep his head clear and direct his plane out of danger. For more than two hours, he navigated his lone bomber away from flak. Only when he reached the English Channel did he agree to take a sedative. He died after the plane landed in England. For his sacrifice, Femoyer received the Medal of Honor.
