- Last assignment was as the command chief master sergeant for U.S. Air Forces in Europe and U.S. Air Forces Africa, Ramstein Air Base
- The CMSAF represents the highest enlisted level of leadership, provides direction for the enlisted corps, and represents Airmen’s interests to the American public and all levels of government.
- The CMSAF is a personal advisor to the Chief of Staff and Secretary of the Air Force regarding the welfare, readiness, morale, proper use, and progress of the enlisted force and their families.
