

Statutory Review

STATES

- Reciprocal Licensure Assessment:
 - A military spouse can receive a license (temporary or renewable for at least one year, or permanent) within 30 days according to statutes in their legislation.
- Minimal Paperwork Assessment:
 - A military spouse can receive a license based on an application and initial submission of minimal documentation according to statutes in their legislation. Minimal documentation is defined as documents which do not require submission by a State or Institution.
- Statutory Key Occupation Coverage:
 - These assessments apply to all health-related occupational licenses currently tracked by the Department of the Air Force.
 - These assessments apply to all education-related occupational licenses currently tracked by the Department of the Air Force.
 - These assessments do not apply to the additional occupational licenses of lawyers and architects.
