The manual also explains different relationship types, how to develop a Mentoring Plan and discussion topics, and provides mentor/mentee checklists. Mentors and mentees should understand the specific guidelines for mentoring, be fully engaged, and be actively involved in planning for mentoring sessions. Mentors and mentees should develop mutual respect, maintain trust and honest communication, and establish a collaborative partnership.
