Reserve Officers' Training  
Corps Instructor and

Vacancies

- Air Force Reserve Officers' Training Corps (ROTC) is a college-level development course dedicated to preparing students to become Airmen.
- Air Force ROTC instructors and detachment commanders are the driving force behind the development of wingmen, leaders, and warriors who adhere to core values of integrity, service, and excellence.
- Air Force ROTC is currently seeking leaders to participate in this rewarding program. Roughly 81 projected instructor vacancies and 13 detachment commander positions are available for summer 2018.

### Who can apply?

- Officers eligible for instructor slots include first lieutenants, captains and majors.
- Active-duty rated officers, line of the Air Force lieutenant colonels and majors selected for lieutenant colonel may apply for detachment commander positions.
- Guard and Reserve officers are eligible to apply for either position under the Voluntary Limited Period of Active Duty (VLPAD) program.

### Eligibility Requirements

- Officers who want to apply for one of these career-broadening leadership positions will find a list of requirements on myPers.
- Interested active-duty officers will find eligibility and application procedures on myPers using the keyword "AFROTC;" Guard and Reserve officers should use the keyword "VLPAD."

### Application Deadlines

- *The application deadlines for the 2018 detachment commander and instructor positions are July 31 and Aug. 1, respectively.*
- **NOTE:** Approximately 39 instructor vacancies are still available for this summer. Additional information is available on myPers under "Hot Jobs."
