Air Force Community Feedback Tool

Air Force Community Feedback Tool (CFT)

The Community Feedback Tool (CFT) is a brief survey which lets Air Force community members identify gaps and strengths in helping services at their local bases. Results will provide timely, actionable information to guide local leaders and programs.

The CFT launched on 2 August 2017 and is open through 2 October 2017. Participation is voluntary and all responses are confidential.

Who is the Air Force CFT For?

All Air Force military personnel, their spouses, and Air Force civilian employees are being invited to take this survey.

The online survey takes about 20 minutes to complete and is the only Air Force survey which collects feedback about local needs and resources.

It can be accessed through either a military or personal computer and does not require a Common Access Card (CAC) for entry.

Why is the Air Force CFT Important?

The Air Force wants to know, from you, what your priorities and concerns are in order to inform program and policy adjustments.

The Air Force CFT will give leadership clear insight into local Air Force communities, prioritized needs, strengths, and perceptions about helping resources.

It will link community strengths and gaps to quality of life outcomes such as:

- Resilience
- Health
- Attitudes about remaining in the military

Input is critical to ensure local, Major Command, and Air Force leaders have the best information possible when developing plans to resolve significant community issues and preserve community strength.

The Air Force CFT is available through the following link ([Take Survey](#)) and requires an access code to enter the survey. Military and civilian personnel have been sent access codes via Air Force email and spouses have been sent postcards to their designated home addresses. Users may receive a security certificate error, but may click on "continue to this website" to access the site.
